

Missouri Southern State University Concealed Carry Weapon Permit Course



(Must be a minimum age of 19 years old)

These courses are open to the public and are
located in our indoor climate controlled firing range (8 hour course)

*Legal and practical aspects of CCW

*Safety & Cleaning

*Loading & Unloading of Weapons

*Firearms Training Simulator Scenarios

*Practicing and qualification of live fire which is necessary to obtain the permit.

New House Bill 294 requirements: permit applicants must shoot a revolver or semi-automatic handgun (50 rounds).

The cost of the Carry Concealed Weapon course is:

\$50.00 – MSSU students/employees (MUST be currently enrolled), supplies own weapon & ammunition.

\$75.00 – Registrant supplies their own weapons and ammunition.

MSSU can provide the use of a weapon and ammunition for the course – Additional cost is \$25.00.
