DEPARTMENT OF TEACHER EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- Grades of C or better in professional education are required for Certification by the State of Missouri
- 12 hrs. maximum -- correspondence courses.
- 40 hrs. minimum of upper division courses.
- 55 hrs. required to enter Jr. Block.
- 2.75 GPA
- Enhanced ACT composite 20 or higher.
- C-Base must be passed before Jr. Block.

Courses with an EDUC prefix cannot be taken until the Jr. Block has been completed. Exceptions: EDUC 100, EDUC 280, and EDUC 304 should be taken prior to Jr. Block.

EDUC 301 must be taken before or concurrently with the Jr. Block.
