

MEN'S ALLOCATIONS

Listed below are the allocations by region for the 2007 Division II Men's Cross Country Championships.

Method of Selection

Teams – (1) All regions automatically qualify two teams, and (2) additional berths are awarded based on the following formula: The region with the first eight finishers in the previous year's national championships are awarded the additional berths for the following year.

Individuals – (1) All eight regions automatically qualify the top two individuals from nonqualifying teams, and (2) all individual competitors who finish in the top five overall places in their respective regional meet and are not a member of a qualifying team will automatically advance to the championships.

TOTAL COMPETITORS

24 teams of seven men each = 168
Individuals + 16 + (Top five overall places that are not a member of a qualifying
