

***CREDIT-IN-ESCROW • April 28, 2008***

The CREDIT-IN-ESCROW program consists of university studies for outstanding high school students who have (1) completed their sophomore year, (2) who have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, (3) who are pursuing the state-designated university preparatory high school curriculum, and (4) who have the recommendation of their principal or counselor. A high school transcript is required with the application form. Application and approval is for one semester only. The stu-

dent must apply each semester. These courses may be taken during the day or evening, and are available in the Fall, Spring, and Summer terms. If the student earns a grade of "C" or better in a CREDIT-IN-ESCROW class, the credit for the course will be held in escrow. Upon successful completion of the course and high school graduation the CREDIT-IN-ESCROW will be placed on the permanent academic record. Call the Admissions Office for further information.
