- Enhanced ACT composite 20 or higher
- C-Base must be passed before Jr. Block

Courses with an EDUC prefix cannot be taken until the Jr. Block has been completed. *Exceptions: EDUC 100, 280, & 302 should be taken **prior** to Jr. Block. EDUC 301 must be taken before or concurrently with the Jr. Block*
