# 1.0 PURPOSE

The University supports the theory that students, parent(s) or legal guardian(s), and the University are partners with responsibilities for the promotion of a healthy and positive educational experience for students. University disciplinary policies and procedures are designed to promote an environment conducive to student learning and growth while protecting the University community.

# **2.0 SCOPE**

This Policy applies to all University students.

# 3.0 POLICY

It is not the intent of the University to institute a policy of parental/guardian notification for every incident involving student use of alcohol or other controlled substances. Rather, University personnel will consider the following when interceding in situations where alcohol or drug abuse: has led to situations which threaten the health or safety of individual a student or students, has contributed to a significant deterioration of the living-learning community; or has interfered with a university sponsored activity or event.

The University may choose to notify parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of a student's misconduct in the area of underage drinking or drug use; however, the University is generally not required to do so.
