## **TEXTBOOKS AND COURSE MATERIALS INFORMATION**

Course materials information for all classes can be found at: [mssubookstore.com](http://mssubookstore.com). After enrolling, a student's booklist may be found online on LioNet or on the MSSU Mobile App. Your booklist will specify the required textbooks requested for your classes. Financial aid can be used for course materials, supplies, and merchandise through the first week of the term.

Course materials may be picked up in store or ordered online at [mssubookstore.com](http://mssubookstore.com). Store hours are posted on the Bookstore website.

Inclusive Access is a program where the required course material will be offered in a digital format through Blackboard on the first day of class. A charge from the MSSU Bookstore, with course and title information, will be placed on your student account. Prior to the start of classes, instructions and information will be sent to your student email. Within that email is a link to your Inclusive Access portal which allows you to opt-out and receive a refund during the first 2 weeks of the spring

### **RENTAL TEXTBOOK RETURNS**

Spring rental books are due by Monday May 15, 2023. If your book(s) is not returned or received with a postmark on or before the due date, the buyout price of the book will be charged to your student account and the book is yours to keep. If you choose to return the book within 25 days beyond the due date the book buyout price will be refunded and a \$14 per hour, per book, extended rental fee will be assessed to your account.

# ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES SPRING

## **PriORARity ENROLLMENT OCTOBER 24-NOVEMBER 21, 2022**

Priority enrollment is by appointment with an academic advisor in the department of your declared major. If undeclared and taking classes on campus or online, by appointment Student Success Center, Hearnes Hall, room 308.

Returning students who were not enrolled during the fall 2022 semester will start the enrollment procedure either in the Admissions Office, Hearnes Hall or online at [mssu.edu/advancement/admissions/](https://mssu.edu/advancement/admissions/).

## **PriORARity ENROLLMENT INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Print your Degree Audit.
2. Make an appointment with your advisor. A list of available appointment times will be posted by the advisor's office. Your advisor will assist you; however, you are responsible for selecting courses. Check the catalog (online at [catalog.mssu.edu](https://catalog.mssu.edu)) for prerequisite requirements.
3. After meeting with your advisor, have the schedule entered in the computer terminal according to your approved enrollment date listed on the schedule below and during the hours posted by the department of your major, or use Web Registration (see below).

**Faculty and Staff may not be available for advising or enrollment during final exams December 12-15 2022.**

## **WEB ENROLLMENT**

You may select the LioNet icon on the MSSU homepage or go to [lionet.mssu.edu](https://lionet.mssu.edu) and choose "Register/Drop Classes" from the Quick Links. Web enrollment is available to currently enrolled students with 30 or more hours who are not on academic probation or suspension. Your log-on ID and password will be required.

Web Registration allows you to enroll yourself for courses that are open if you have met the prerequisites and there is not a time conflict with your other courses. Before you can web register:

- You should consult with your advisor.
- Holds for academic or financial reasons must be cleared.
- Your assigned beginning enrollment date applies.
- See the PriORARity Enrollment schedule dates listed on page 1.
- After the first week of the term, students will not be permitted to make changes to their schedule through LioNet.

You also have the option to enroll in person through your advisor on or after your assigned date. If you have problems using Web enrollment, please see your advisor. ## **SPECIAL ENROLLMENT**

**January 23-27, 2023**

Adding a single class or enrolling in multiple classes will be done in the appropriate department of the class only with the permission of the instructor and chair of the department offering the course. ## **DUAL CREDIT/DUAL ENROLLMENT**

**Mission:** The mission of the MSSU Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment Program, in collaboration with area high schools, is to provide geographically feasible and affordable access to quality university-level undergraduate education to high-performing high school students in order to enrich the high school educational experience as well as foster a smooth transition from high school to a four-year university.

**Student Eligibility:** Student eligibility information is available through the Missouri Department of Higher Education website. Please visit [dhe.mo.gov/policies/dual-credit.php](https://dhe.mo.gov/policies/dual-credit.php) for the most up-to-date student eligibility information.

**Dual Credit:** Dual credit enables qualified high school students to take university-level courses taught by qualified high school instructors. Students simultaneously receive academic credit for the course from both the high school and MSSU.

**Dual Enrollment:** Dual enrollment enables qualified high school students to take university-level courses taught by an MSSU faculty member while simultaneously enrolled in the high school and MSSU. Credit is typically only awarded at the university level; however, students may be eligible to earn high school credit for such courses with approval from the high school district.

## **SIXTY-FIVE PLUS PROGRAM (65+)**

The Sixty-Five Plus Program (formerly the Sixty-Plus Program) is a tuition waiver offered by Missouri Southern State University designed for community members sixty-five years of age or older (65+) who would like to take on campus classes (audit only) with a special pricing benefit.

65+ students receive a 100% tuition waiver for three credit hours per semester. Book rental charges, ID card, course supplies, special course fees, and repeated courses are the student's responsibility. A \$25 enrollment/processing fee will be applied each semester. **Continuing Education, online and graduate-level classes are not eligible for the Sixty-Five Plus Program.**

New 65+ students must be admitted to the university before they may register. To apply for admission, contact the Admissions Office in Hearnes Hall room 106 or call 417-625-9378.

Students may register during Regular Enrollment in the Registrar's office in Hearnes Hall room 101 or by calling 417-625-9389.

## **AUDITING A COURSE**

The cost to AUDIT is the same as for a credit course. The student must apply for admission, enroll in the course and obtain a "Permit to Audit" from the Registrar's Office. The signatures of the instructor as well as the Dean must be obtained.

The signed "Permit to Audit" must be returned to the Registrar's Office, 101 Hearnes Hall, by the end of the second week of classes. No change from audit to credit or from credit to audit may be made after the second week of classes.

## **STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES**

Classes and other services designed to meet the special academic needs of students are offered through the Center. The Student Success Center hours during the summer are Monday thru Thursday 7:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M. and Monday thru Friday 8:00 A.M. – 5:00 P.M. during the fall and spring semesters.

### **Tutoring in Content Areas and Writing**

Peer tutors are available. Tutoring is by drop-in, online and appointment basis. Both short- and long-term assistance is provided.

## **STUDENT ACCOUNT PAYMENT DUE DATES**

Students who have pre-registered for the spring 2023 term are required to view their student account balance on LioNet upon enrollment. 100% of the student's account balance will be due by the published due date. This balance may be paid in full, via payment(s) to the student account, an institutional payment plan [mssu.edu/paymybill](https://mssu.edu/paymybill), authorized financial aid or a combination of these options.

## **SPRING 2023 DUE DATE: WEDNESDAY JANUARY 25, 2023 BY 5:00 P.M.**

100% of the total student account balance is due in full, prior to 5:00 P.M. on Wednesday of the second week of classes (the 7<sup>th</sup> business day). Failure to remit the balance required by the published due date may result in an immediate hold.

(100%): FRIDAY JANUARY 27, 2023.

### **THIRD WEEK THROUGH WEDNESDAY OF THE FOURTH WEEK**

(50%): WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 8, 2023.

Student responsible for 50% of tuition and fees  
50% refund is not applicable to special course or records fees.

### **AFTER WEDNESDAY OF THE FOURTH WEEK**

(NONE): BEGINNING THURSDAY FEBRUARY 9, 2023.

Student is responsible for 100% of tuition and fees.

**NOTE:** Dates may vary for Off-Schedule classes. Withdrawal & refund of fees information listed only pertains to full-term fall classes running from January 17 through May 5, 2023. Student must contact the Registrar's Office for information on off-schedule courses. Direct questions about course charges to the Bursar's Office.

If you do not wish to remain enrolled for spring of 2023, please complete the total withdrawal form to be removed from your classes and to receive a refund in tuition. Friday January 27, 2023 is the deadline to receive the 100% refund for fall full-term classes. ## **REPAYMENT NOTICE for FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID**

- Students who withdraw earlier than 60% of the semester will be subject to repayment of part or all of their aid, as determined by Federal Regulations. This includes official and unofficial withdrawals stemming from student's last date of attendance prior to the 60% of semester earned.
- Students will be notified in writing of any amount due. A hold will be placed on the student's account until repayment is made in full.
- Students must make repayment of their portion of financial aid within 45 days. Failure to make repayment within 45 days will result in:
  1. Referral to the U.S. Department of Education for collection.
  2. Ineligibility for federal financial aid from all colleges and universities until the repayment of aid and interest due is paid to the U.S. Department of Education.

## **WITHDRAWAL POLICY**

Students who do not officially cancel their enrollment will be responsible for tuition and fees as indicated above. **NON-ATTENDANCE DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A WITHDRAWAL FROM CLASSES.** Please confirm your registration in LioNet (not Blackboard).

**WITHDRAWAL FROM A SINGLE CLASS FOR FULL TERM CLASSES:** Prior to the first day of the semester, students may contact their advisor to be dropped from a single class or drop themselves through LioNet if they eligible to self-enroll. Beginning the first day of the third week of the semester students may complete the online [Single Course Withdrawal form](#) on the Office of the Registrar website or complete the paper form available in the Office of the Registrar. The official date of withdrawal is the date the form is RECEIVED in the Office of the Registrar.

### **WITHDRAWING FROM A SINGLE CLASS FOR PART-OF-TERM CLASSES.**

Prior to the first day of the semester, students may contact their advisor to be dropped from a single class or drop themselves through LioNet if they eligible to self-enroll. Beginning the second day of the second week of the class students may complete the online [Single Course Withdrawal form](#) on the Office of the Registrar website or complete the paper form in the Office of the Registrar. The official date of withdrawal is the date the form is RECEIVED in the Office of the Registrar.

**WITHDRAWAL FROM ALL CLASSES:** Prior to the first day of the semester the student should contact their advisor to withdraw from their classes or they can withdraw their classes through LioNet, if eligible to do so. Beginning the first day of the semester students who wish to withdraw from all their classes must see the university exit counselor in the Financial Aid Office, Hearnese Hall. After the deadline for full refund of charges deadline, Federal financial aid recipients who withdraw from all classes will automatically be placed on Financial Aid Suspension.

## LioNet

LioNet is Missouri Southern State University's web portal that provides personalized access to web services. In separate mailings students receive their LioNet ID number, or SID (begins with S and is followed by 8 numbers) and LioNet default PIN (6 alpha-numeric characters). Login with the LioNet ID, making certain to use a capital S and the number zero, not the letter o. Your password is the LioNet default PIN. Be sure to enter any letters of your PIN in upper-case. The PIN will also be used for registration.

All registered students have access to course information, group tools, campus life, work life, personal calendars, email, and more – anytime, anywhere. The student can use LioNet to check their schedule, fees (including payment of fees), personal information, transcript, grades and to see campus announcements. Students can check grade reports and fee statements on LioNet.

## Degree Works Audit

A Degree Works audit is an online version of a degree requirements checklist. It includes a listing of completed, in-progress, and future coursework, and other graduation requirements.

Audits are organized by blocks. The blocks show what requirements are needed for a specific degree, major, and minor. The tool helps with planning registration to fulfill the requirements within each block and keeps you on target for graduation. Print a Degree Works audit when meeting with your advisor prior to registration.

### To View a Degree Evaluation

1. Access your LioNet account
2. Go to the Student Quick Links area
3. Click on Degree Evaluation (Degree Works)

Audits may be printed or saved as a pdf.

## ENROLLMENT CONFIRMATION IN LIONET

Students who are pre-registered for the upcoming term must complete the Enrollment Confirmation process to indicate they plan or do not plan to attend. Confirmation dates are posted below. For Fall and Spring semesters, the Enrollment Confirmation deadline is the Monday of the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the semester. For summer semester, it is the Monday of the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of the 8-week session.

# DIGITAL LEARNING

Missouri Southern offers a large selection of online (Internet) programs and courses. For a complete listing of online programs visit the Department of Digital Learning's website: <https://www.mssu.edu/academics/distance-learning/>. Most online courses follow the same semester schedule as on-campus courses, but some do not. Be sure to carefully check the schedule for Delayed Start and other part-of-term courses.

Internet classes are not recommended for students with only dial-up or cellular Internet connections. Online students should not expect to complete all Internet course activities on a cellular phone or other mobile device. Students interested in completing Internet classes at MSSU must have access to a reliable laptop or desktop computer with high-speed (DSL, cable, fiber-optic) Internet access. A small number of courses require a Windows computer (PC). Be sure to pay close attention to course descriptions.

Internet courses are instructor-led, not self-paced, and students are expected to actively participate on a weekly basis, from the very first day of classes. Distance students run the risk of being dropped from any online course for lack of participation (submitting an assignment, posting to a discussion board, etc.) during the first seven days of the class. This drop could lead to the loss of Financial Aid.

Missouri Southern's primary learning management system (LMS) for distance course delivery is Blackboard™. MSSU's Blackboard™ can be found on the landing page of the "Students" section of the University website: <https://www.mssu.edu/student.php>. Student login credentials are provided by the Information Technology department. For assistance with login credentials contact the I.T. ## Blackboard Course Availability:

Blackboard sites for all courses will appear in Blackboard two-days prior to the official start date of classes. This extra time should be used by students to review important course documents in the "Course Home" area of each course. Students should not expect discussion board or email correspondence with professors to begin prior to the official start date of the course. Face-to-face courses also have Blackboard sites, but the extent to which they are used is entirely up to the instructor.

## New Online Student Orientation:

First-time distance students are automatically enrolled in the Department of Digital Learning's "Chalk Talk Blackboard Prep for Students" Blackboard Organization. Activities in this course are optional, providing Missouri Southern's new distance learners with information relevant to being a distance student, including the use of various Blackboard functions used by MSSU online instructors. The "Chalk Talk Blackboard Prep for Students" Blackboard Organization should automatically appear in new online students' Blackboard Organizations section shortly after registration and no sooner than two weeks prior to the semester start date. ## Complete Proctored Exams Online:

Students taking online classes requiring proctored tests, which are tests that must be taken in the physical presence of a testing monitor, will be provided the option of completing such exams online, see the course syllabus. To take advantage of this option, students will need a high-speed internet connection and computer with audio/video capabilities. Students also have the option of completing proctored exams at physical testing locations. There may be a charge associated with taking proctored exams at physical locations other than Missouri Southern's campus. For more information on proctored exams in distance courses see the Testing Procedures for Distance Courses section.

## COURSE WITHDRAWAL PROCEDURE FOR DISTANCE STUDENTS:

**WITHDRAWAL FROM A SINGLE CLASS FOR FULL TERM CLASSES:** Prior to the first day of the semester, students may contact their advisor to be dropped from a single class or drop themselves through LioNet if they eligible to self-enroll. Beginning the first day of the third week of the semester, students may complete [Single Course Withdrawal form](#). The official date of withdrawal is the date the form is submitted through the form portal.

**WITHDRAWAL FROM ALL CLASSES:** Prior to the first day of the semester, students may contact their advisor to withdraw from their classes or they can withdraw from their classes through LioNet, if eligible to do so. Beginning the first day of the semester distance learning students who wish to withdraw from all their

classes must see reach out to the university exit counselor in the Financial Aid Office at [faid@mssu.edu](mailto:faid@mssu.edu) to receive information and instructions on how to completely withdraw from their classes. After the deadline for full refund of charges, Federal financial aid recipients who withdraw from all classes will automatically be placed on Financial Aid Suspension.

## COURSE MATERIAL FOR DISTANCE STUDENTS:

Students who live more than 30 miles from the MSSU campus (**off-campus students**), can test on campus or with an approved proctor.

Students needing a remote proctor should contact Testing Services for assistance. To request approval for a remote proctor please use Testing Services Proctor Agreement Form, linked below. The Testing Services Office must approve all proctors before tests are emailed to a proctor's location. Once the proctor is approved, the student may continue to utilize them. If the student lives in Springfield, St. Louis, Kansas City, Cassville, Lamar, Nevada, Neosho, and some parts of Arkansas, we may have proctors who have already been approved, please contact us for information. Local testing centers or libraries should always be utilized first. Testing Services can help with this.

Students are responsible for any remote proctor fees. If required, students may have to pay a charge for the Proctor's time and effort.
