MSSU Athletics Report

1. Sport Program Reports

- a. <u>Football –</u> The Missouri Southern football team will be in action this weekend at the University of Central Oklahoma. The Lions are 1-6 and the Bronchos are 1-6. The game will be broadcast on 101.3, 103.5 and 88.7 FM, while also being on AM 1560.
- **b.** <u>Women's Soccer</u> The Missouri Southern women's soccer team is 3-8-2 on the season and will play at Central Missouri on Friday and Lindenwood on Sunday. The team will host its senior day on Oct. 28 against Southwest Baptist at 6 pm.
- in the 2016 MIAA Cross Country Championships, hosted by Lindenwood University. The Southern men are the second-ranked team in the Central Region and are ranked 16th nationally. The men have won every Division II meet they have entered this year, and placed fifth at the University of Arkansas Chile Pepper Invitational. The Men have also had the MIAA Cross Country runner of the week every week they have raced (Vincent Kiprop 3 times, Cody Berry once). Kiprop is the top ranked runner in Division II and has been the national runner of the week twice this year. The women have had the MIAA Runner of the Week once (Emily Harris). The Lions have finished in the top six in every meet they have entered with a win at Missouri S&T and a second-place finish at Southwest Baptist. The women are ranked seventh in the Central Region.
- d. <u>Golf –</u> The Missouri Southern golf team ended its fall season this past week at Lindenwood in an MIAA points event. The Lions are in third place in the MIAA standings at the halfway mark of the 2016-17 season. Taylor Lansford shot a career-low 66 to earn a tie for the top MIAA golfer at Lindenwood and shared MIAA Golfer of the Week honors this week. Lansford is sixth, while Tristan Haltom is 11th in the MIAA Individual Standings.
- e. <u>Volleyball –</u> The Missouri Southern volleyball team will be on the road this weekend playing at Missouri Western on Friday and Northwest Missouri on Saturday. The Lions are 4-18 overall on the season.
- f. <u>Basketball</u> The Missouri Southern men's and women's basketball teams opened up practice this past weekend. The teams will be up front and center on Tuesday, October 25 as Southern hosts MOSO Madness in the Leggett & Platt Athletic Center. Both teams will have a scrimmage as well as various skills challenges. The MSSU women have an exhibition at home against Livin The Dream on November 8 and open up the regular season on Nov. 12 and 13 participating in the MIAA/GAC Challenge at Emporia State. The Southern men will open up the regular season on Nov. 11 and 12 participating in the MIAA/NSIC Challenge at St. Cloud State University.

2. MIAA News:

- **a.** New MIAA Commissioner Visit: The search committee designated Mike Racy and the new commissioner of the MIAA. He will officially begin in November. He will be coming to MSSU to visit with university officials and athletic department staff on November 29th.
- **b.** <u>Lincoln University Violation-</u>MIAA Response: The MIAA nullified the results of the women's champion in the 200m, 400m and 4X100m due to her performance as an ineligible athlete. This changed the scoring but not the final finish for our women's program.

c. <u>Future Scheduling Study:</u> The CEO's approved a **Recommendation** from the AAC to study the concept of a basketball schedule utilizing a **Thursday-Saturday–Monday** format. For the **2017-18** season the women would play on Thursday-Saturday and the men would play on Saturday-Monday. The results would be presented for *potential acceptance or rejection* at the December 2016 AAC meeting. The Commissioner was directed to lead this initiative and facilitate this study for AAC review and action.

- a. <u>NCAA Reporting:</u> The Equity in Athletics Data Analysis (EADA) is due by Oct. 28th. MSSU Athletics works collaboratively with the Treasurer's office and Foundation office to complete the report.
- **b.** <u>Potential Division 2 Legislation:</u> The NCAA Division II second publication of proposed legislation has been distributed to the membership. MSSU has worked with our Student-Athlete Advisory Committee to complete their grids for the conference office and is currently in the process of informing our coaches and staff of the proposed legislation. - c. <u>NCAA ISSG (Institutional Self Study Guide):</u> The department has begun discussions on committee makeup in order to prepare for the report in 2018. The Athletic Department has begun the preliminary meetings for the ISSG.
