MSSU Athletics Report

1. Sport Program Reports

- a. <u>Football –</u> The Missouri Southern football team will begin spring practice on March 29 with a final scrimmage commencing on April 22. The spring schedule will consist of 13 practice dates and two scrimmage dates of the 15 total days. Practices will start at 3:15 p.m. during the week with the Saturday practices/scrimmages starting at 2 p.m.
- **b.** <u>Men's Basketball</u> The Missouri Southern men's basketball team finished the season 18-12 and had four players selected All-MIAA, including MIAA Freshman of the Year Elyjah Clark. Clark was an All-MIAA pick, as well as CJ Carr, JJ Cratit and Lawrence Brown.
- c. <u>Women's Basketball</u> The Missouri Southern women's basketball finished the season 12-17 and had two players selected All-MIAA with Deb Holcomb and Desirea Buerge earning honors.
- d. <u>Track and Field</u> The Missouri Southern Men's and women's track and field teams competed well at the 2017 NCAA Division II Indoor Championships. Vincent Kiprop was the National Champion in the 5k and runner up in the 3k. Bryan Burns was a first-team All-American in the shot put, while Morgan Hold was a second-team All-American in the pole vault. Emily Presley was the national runner up in the pole vault and Allie Heckemeyer was a second-team All-American in the pentathlon. The men's team is in fourth-place in the United States Track and Field and Cross Country Coaches Association Program of the Year award standings, while the women's team won the award for the highest team GPA at the National Championships with a 3.59 cumulative team GPA.
- e. <u>Baseball</u> The Missouri Southern baseball team is 13-10 and 5-4 in the MIAA. Max Hogan leads the MIAA in eight different offensive categories, while ranking in the top 20 nationally of 11 different categories. The Lions play host to Missouri Western this weekend in a three-game series at Warren Turner Field.
- f. <u>Softball</u> The Missouri Southern softball team is 9-16 overall and plays in St. Joseph this weekend at the Missouri Western Tournament. Abi Corbett is 7th nationally in hits and leads the MIAA in that category. Taurean Guzman is 19th nationally in saves and second in the MIAA in that category.
- g. <u>Golf –</u> The Missouri Southern golf team started up the spring season this week in a snow-shortened event at Washburn. The Lions were in sixth place as a team with Chase Rogers finishing 15th individually.
