# **MSSU Athletics Report**

# 1. Sport Program Reports

- **a.** Men's Basketball The Men's Basketball team is off to a 10-5 start and is 4-2 in the MIAA. Junior Austin Wright recently set a new MSSU single-game three-point record with nine three's against Northeastern State on Jan. 10. The team will play at Lincoln on Saturday.
- **b.** Women's Basketball The Women's Basketball team is 9-4 on the season and just recently held Northeastern State to its lowest point total in school history after moving to the Division II ranks when the Lions won 50-34 this past Saturday. Southern held the RiverHawks to just nine points in the first half in the win. The Lions play at Lincoln on Saturday.
- c. Men's and Women's Track and Field The track and field teams will play host to the MSSU open this Friday and Saturday at the Leggett & Platt Athletic Center. Events begin at 2:30 pm on Friday and 10:30 am on Saturday. The MSSU Men are ranked 6th nationally, while the women are ranked 20th nationally. Jeff Fraley ranks second nationally in both the 60m and the 400m. He has automatically qualified in the 60m. Morgan Hold ranks 5th nationally in the men's pole vault, while Darion Boure ranks sixth in the triple jump. On the women's side, Melanie Bower ranks 11th nationally in the pole vault and Kaylee Morgan is 11th in the long jump.
- **d. Spring Sports** Baseball and Softball have begun practice and will have their first games next month. Golf gets back into the swing of things in March.
- **e. State Farm Trophy Series:** We are up 3-1 in the State Farm Trophy Series Standings. Wins from Volleyball and both cross country programs.

### 2. MIAA News:

**a.** The 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting for the Strategic Planning Committee in October. Rachel Burleson is representing MSSU. The MIAA Strategic Plan Outline and the current existing Strategic Plan has been reviewed on each campus. The Strategic Plan Outline is now being voted on by the Presidents today at 3PM in Washington, DC.

### 3. NCAA News:

**a.** Current proposed legislation is under review and will be voted on tomorrow at the NCAA Convention in Washington, D.C.; nothing too controversial to be discussed at this time.

#### 4. Athletic Department Information:

- a. Record High GPA: Our overall GPA for Fall 2014 was 3.06! Men's Teams were 2.75 and Women were 3.36. The highest GPA for the men was Men's Cross Country/Track with a 3.06 and women was Women's Basketball with a 3.53; this is third time in the last six years the athletic department has accomplished that feat. It is quite an achievement to have over 320 students in a variety of majors to average above the 3.0 mark! Congratulations to all the student-athletes, the fine instructors at MSSU, our dedicated athletic department tutors and academic coordinators and Rachel Burleson, our SWA and Assistant Athletic Director.
- b. Graduation The Athletic Department had 23 current or former student-athletes participate in the Winter Commencement ceremonies this past December. Among the graduates were two graduating Summa Cum Laude, as well as one graduating Magna Cum Laude. Jake Benton finished with a perfect

4.00 GPA and is currently in Kenya interning at a hospital, while training for the 2016 Olympic Trials. <u>Also notable was the graduation of former player Johnny Berry, who passed away in a car accident in August.</u>

- c. Season Ticket Offer- Athletic Marketing and Athletic Game Management had set aside some time throughout the weeks since Thanksgiving to call former season ticket holders who have not renewed about doing so this year. Some of the objections we have encountered regarding not renewing is not being able to make it to all the games. In response, we have created a weekend conference game package. It is for the 5 conference games that fall on Saturday's. The price would be \$60. We advertised this officially after Thanksgiving as a "stocking stuffer" gift. This generated 5 more season ticket holders for this basketball season.
- **d. Ticket Office-** We are considering looking at other ticketing software before the 2015 fall sports season. ExtremeTix, our current system, lacks on customer service and has caused us some formatting errors this basketball season that has upset some Lionbackers. The review process will begin by early February 2015.
- **e. Web Streaming Away Basketball Games-** Residents life is streaming away men's and women's basketball games in bottom floor of Mayes student center in the theatre. Everyone is invited to attend if you would like to see the game.
- **f. Our Make-A-Wish campaign-** is well underway and we have raised over **\$1500** as of now which is almost triple what we accomplished last year. This has been driven by our SAAC and their collective sport teams. They have done such things as trivia contests, 50-50, Bingo and other great activities.
- g. Athletic Marketing- It is time for the Joplin Business Expo, where over 1,000 business owners and area residents will be at the convention center in Joplin. Each year we ask each head coach and or assistant coach to take a two hour time slot. This is a great opportunity for them to be out in the public eye and talk to people about our programs. We will provide lion decals that are handed out by the coaches.
- h. Midyear Transfers- In combination during the early signing date in November for the sports of Football, Basketball, Baseball, and Track and Cross Country we have <u>19</u> new midyear student-athletes for the Spring Semester.

## 5. Lionbacker Annual Campaign:

a. We currently have 274 Lionbackers Memberships paid for representing around 730 people. We have 53 new memberships this year and the rest are renewals. We are currently renewed at 78% of our total memberships from last year. We have our highest total of both Lionbacker donation dollars & Season Ticket dollars we have ever had.

- **a.** Friday Dec 12<sup>th</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual MOSO Trivia Night in the BSC Ballroom We held our 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual MOSO Trivia Night in December this year. We had 24 teams compete this year and approximately 150 people attend. This is our highest attendance for this event. It continues to be one of our best received events with extremely positive feedback and it is a lot of fun for us to put on. It raised around \$7,500 this year. Dr. Mike LaFerla's team "The Average Joe's" took home the crown this year.
- b. Sat Jan 10<sup>th</sup> Lionbacker Appreciation Day Chili Feed in Young Gym– We had our Annual Lionbacker Appreciation Day Chili Feed on Jan 10<sup>th</sup>. We held it prior to the Women's Basketball game starting at Noon. It was our highest attendance yet for this event with around 140 people there. It is a great opportunity for us to thank our Lionbackers for their support as well as a great chance for interaction between the Booster Club Members. We also take the time to honor those Lionbackers we have passed away. It is a very popular event that keeps growing each year.
