ACADEMIC POLICY ISSUES /

There are several substantive issues the faculty will deliberate this semester through various committees of the Faculty Senate and through the administreative structure. They include:

- Student Residency: is the current policy of 30 of the last 36 consistent with our peers and reflective of today's student educational patters?
- Upper Division: what does it mean to be in "upper division" in terms of curriculuar progression, learning ourcomes and requirements?
- Bachelor of General Studies: we have about 200 students in this primary major. To optimize their academic opportunities, we are going to evaluate the feability of tracks and shared student learning outcomes.
- DFW Rates: we will identify some specific courses on which we will focus to understand and improve rates.
- CIP changes and their impact.
- Critical Thinking (and Communication) "minor" is being developed for potential inclusion in Yours to Lose curriculum as well as in others.
- Your to Lose admissions criteria and curriculum are being developed. We will meet with the KCU team tomorrow.
