

APPLICANT ACCEPTANCE OF POSITION OFFERED

Upon notification of being accepted, the student will need to provide:

1. A WRITTEN LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE, AND
2. \$200.00 ORIENTATION FEE (**NON-REFUNDABLE**)

ONCE ACCEPTED: ACCEPTED APPLICANTS WILL BE REQUIRED to attend a **MANDATORY** orientation on the main campus in Joplin in JULY. An orientation package will be sent to all accepted applicants.

STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING **PRIOR TO ORIENTATION:** (Forms will be provided upon notification of admission and **MUST** be completed and signed by appropriate providers.)

2. A mandatory Dental Hygiene Applicant consultation with a Willcoxon Health Center representative, in the spring semester before beginning Dental Hygiene in August, and complete all immunizations and examinations. Documentation of each of the following must be submitted to the Willcoxon Health Center prior to Orientation.
 - A. Physical Examination with Complete Blood Count, less than 6 months prior to entering the program.
 - B. Dental Exam
 - C. Visual Exam
 - D. Hepatitis A and B Immunizations/Titers
 - E. Tuberculin Test
 - F. Tetanus/TDAP
 - G. Measles, Mumps, Rubella, and Varicella Immunizations.

3. Proof of Health Insurance.
4. Basic Life Support for Health Care Providers – 2 year certification, not to expire before mid-June of students 2nd year in the dental hygiene program.
5. Upon receipt and review, a signed copy of the Communicable Disease Policy.

NOTE: Failure to complete the 6 requirements listed above will result in loss of eligibility for admission to the dental hygiene program.
