Cooperating Teacher Service Scholarship

The Cooperating Teacher Service Scholarship recognizes master teachers who are dedicated to working with and mentoring Missouri Southern Teacher Education students during clinical field experiences. The scholarship is available to junior internship cooperating teachers. The scholarship consists of one credit hour of graduate tuition waived for each semester of service, for a maximum of three credits or one three-hour course. Semesters of service are not required to be consecutive. The scholarship earned must be redeemed for EDUC prefix courses only and must be within three years of the initial semester of service, regardless of the number of credits.

To redeem credit for service as a cooperating teacher, applicants must complete the required application below. The scholarship is awarded to cooperating teachers who fulfill all required obligations of the junior internship, including all intern evaluations, cooperating teacher survey completion, and duration of practicum hours.
